Sometimes the name of the United Kingdom is shortened to **the UK**.

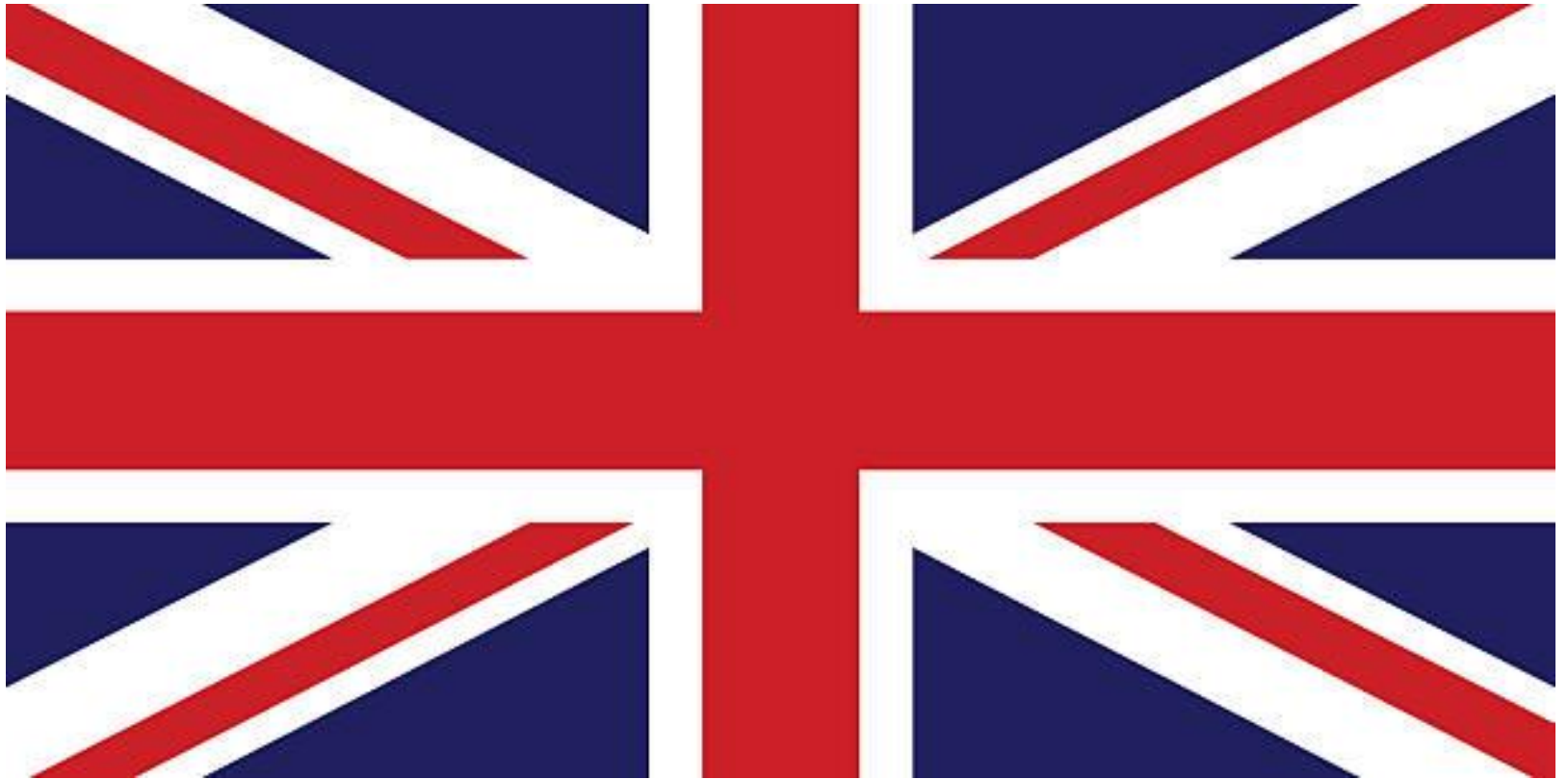


# Here is the map of the UK.

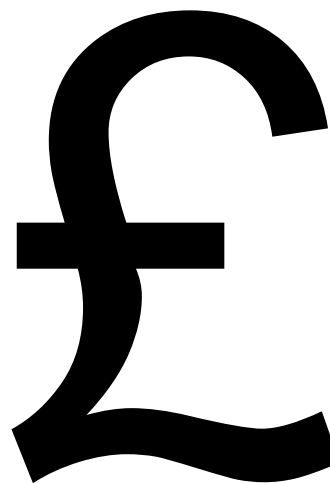

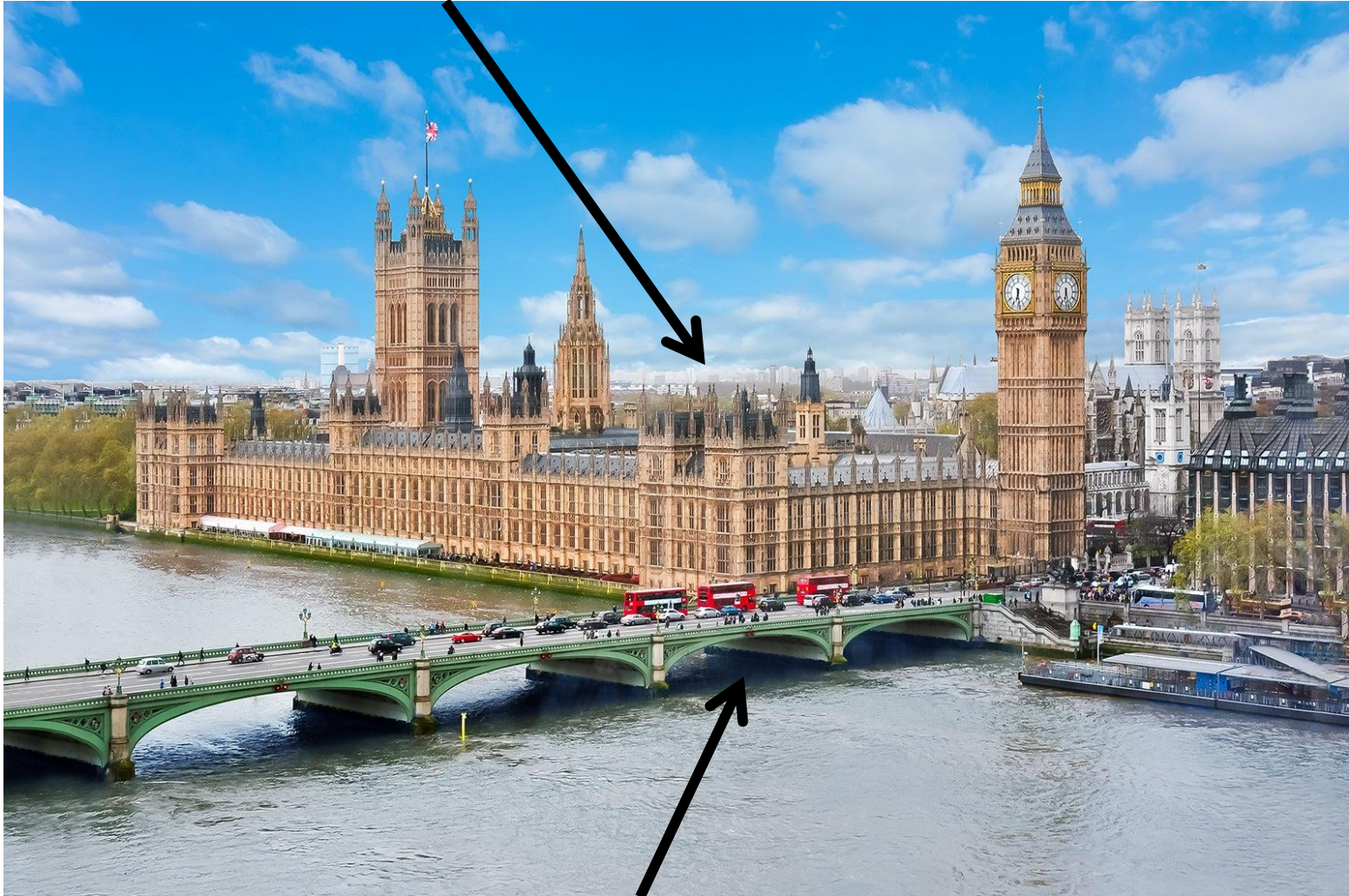


The National Gallery is an art museum.
